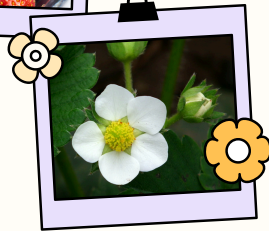


STRAWBERRY

It is widely appreciated for its characteristic aroma, bright red color, and sweetness. It is consumed in large quantities as jam, juice and ice cream.

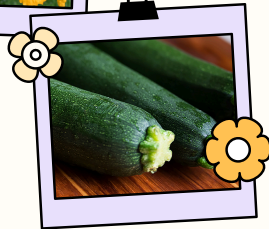


COURGETTE
